

1 | Changing Places

In this topic, you will get to explore how we engage with and provide places with meanings, memories and perceptions. You will look at how different outlets can manipulate our connections with places and gain an understanding of how places change over time.

2 | Global Governance and Global Systems

In this topic, you will look at the concept of globalisation and how different forces have shaped the social, environmental and economic world around us. You will also explore the concept of 'Global commons' - areas with no country alliance and the issues surrounding these areas.

3 | Population and the Environment

In this topic, you will investigate how human population changes influence the physical environment around us and the associated challenges. You will also get to research different theoretical approaches to population theory and the potential outcomes of our growth.



1 | Hazards

A direct development from GCSE, in this topic you will investigate different hazards around the world in greater detail. You will also appreciate how humans respond to hazards in different regions of the world and engage with the relationships between people and the environments they occupy.

2 | Water and Carbon Cycle

In this topic, you will gain high level knowledge into the water & carbon cycles including how they work, the impact of these systems on the planet and how humans affect them, including climate change. You will also investigate the current methods of climate change mitigation in detail.

3 | Coastal systems and landscapes

A direct development from GCSE, in this topic you will investigate how these dynamic environments change over time and the driving forces behind them. You will also understand the importance of these zones as human habitats and human intervention for coastal preservation.

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
