## What should I get in preparation for September?



It would be a good idea to start to build a selection of photography resources at home. These could include images of inspiration from newspapers/ magazines or screenshots on your phone. Photography props that you would like to use in your shoot.

If you have a camera experiment with using it and familiarise yourself with the settings.

Explore free editing apps and techniques on your phone.


Create a Pinterest board of inspirational photography to help keep you inspired.

#### You will need:

1x A4 display book with a minimum of 100 pockets Exacompta - Ref 85103E - Soft PP Display Book - Suitable for A4 Documents, Made from Polypropylene, Lightweight, 100 Pockets, 200 Viewing Pages - Green Cover : Amazon.co.uk: Stationery & Office Supplies

1 x copy of the Handmaid's Tale- Margaret Attwood- (You can borrow a copy over the summer whilst you get your own)

It is a good idea to also buy a set of highlighters and some post it notes to use while reading and annotating along with your usual equipment (pen, ruler etc).





#### How will this be assessed in September?

All work will need to be presented on a PowerPoint presentation that you have shared with me. Your slide size will need to be set to A4 size.

You will be expected to share your google slides presentation with me before the first Photography lesson when we return to school in September. You will be given feedback in relation to the assessment objectives.





### Watch it:



If you want to you can watch 'The Handmaid's Tale' HBO series on a streaming platform. This is an optional task. Remember to not let the visual creativity of the series impact your own shoots and representation of the quote/extract from the book.



## Do it:

Read 'The Handmaid's Tale' select 3 quotes or extracts that you can then represent visually through shoots. Use the quote or extract as the starting point for your slides. For each quote or extract you will need to produce:

- Inspirational images
- Shoot plan
- Shoot
- Edits
- Present you best images (Between 1-4) from each shoot with analysis of how you have visually represented the quote or extract.

Complete your work on a PowerPoint presentation (Please make sure you set your slides to A4 size) - on our first lesson back I will give you time to print work to put into your book. The presentation must be emailed/shared with me. Polly.turmer@plymptonacademy.tsat.uk
