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# What should I get in preparation for September?

1 A4 lever arch folder (not a ring binder - they are too small)

File dividers

Plastic wallets

If possible, buy this <u>grammar and translation workbook</u> for around £8 to support your understanding of Spanish grammar.

Also, I'd recommend buying a Spanish dictionary if you can. The unabridged, or big one, costs around £28 <a href="here">here</a>, which is most appropriate for A Level, but is very expensive. The condensed one, such as <a href="this one">this one</a>, will cost around £4, or £8 if you buy <a href="this one">this one</a> with grammar explanations included. Just bear in mind, both of these versions won't contain every word so you may not always be able to find what you need.
